New Feature

Ivanti Endpoint Manager Console integration

Environment Manager Policy (EM) & Endpoint Manager (EPM) 2018.1 products are now integrated to simplify the process of managing your EM configurations and agent deployments on EPM managed devices. This provides Administrators with the following capabilities:

Open, Edit and Save Configurations directly from within EM Console

Connect the 2018.1 EM Console directly to an available EPM 2018.1 instance to return a list of current EM configurations. Choose a configuration for update and after making the necessary updates, save the configuration to EPM as a new revision of the existing package for deployment.

Saving a new configuration is just as easy, either create from new or import an existing configuration into the console before connecting to your EPM server and deploy as a new distribution package.

EM Agent installation via EPM Console

Customers can deploy the EM 2018.1 Agent via Endpoint Manager's Windows Agent Configuration feature.

This feature integration is only available for customers of both Environment Manager Policy & Endpoint Manager products from 2018.1 and above.
