The services are now contained in the Cherwell Service Host and referred to as microservices. The Cherwell Service Host, its four microservices, and Cherwell Message Queue Service (CherwellMQS) are automatically installed with the Server Installation, but you can choose which microservices to enable by default. You can later enable or disable microservices and configure logging for each microservice in the Cherwell Server Manager.
