MobileIron AppStation is a dedicated client for a MAM-only deployment. A MAM-only deployment allows you to distribute and manage apps without having to manage the device itself.

## New features and enhancements summary

This release includes the following new features and enhancements:

- Rebranding: MobileIron has updated the AppStation for iOS icon and user interface color scheme. See "What users see in MobileIron AppStation for iOS" in the MobileIron AppStation for iOS Guide.
- Privacy disclaimer: Device users see a privacy disclaimer when they register with MobileIron Cloud using MobileIron AppStation. Tap Continue to acknowledge the disclaimer and continue with registration. See "Register AppStation with MobileIron Cloud" in the MobileIron AppStation for iOS Guide.
- Support for MobileIron Go and MobileIron AppStation on the same device: The support allows for the MAM-only use case where you have contractors whose devices are already managed by another instance of MobileIron Cloud, however, you need to deploy required apps from your instance of MobileIron Cloud to the device. The supported MAM-only use cases are described in the "MAM-only use cases with MobileIron AppStation" and "MobileIron Go and MobileIron AppStation interaction" sections of the MobileIron AppStation for iOS Guide.
- Support for MobileIron Tunnel: MobileIron productivity apps, Email+, Web@Work, and Docs@Work, in a MAM-only AppStation deployment can use Tunnel to access enterprise resources. For Web@Work, if any traffic generated in Web@Work falls within the IP range configured for Tunnel, the traffic is tunneled. For more information see "MobileIron Tunnel support" in the MobileIron AppStation for iOS Guide.

MobileIron Threat Defense protects managed devices from mobile threats and vulnerabilities affecting device, network, and applications. - ILP-514: An upgrade to AppStation 1.3.0 is not supported. If you already have AppStation 1.1.0 installed on your device, uninstall 1.1.0, then install 1.3.0. Re-register with your MobileIron UEM (Cloud or Core) after installing AppStation 1.3.0.
- ILP-485: To fix an AppConnect start up issue, before installing AppStation 1.3.0, update any AppConnect apps to AppConnect 4.5.2 for iOS. For more information, see <u>AppConnect for iOS: Mandatory Updates for Client App Compatibility</u> on the <u>MobileIron Support Community</u>.
- ILP-511: Phishing VPN is not installed if On-demand VPN is enabled before the upgrade.
